### How do birds use native vegetation re-plantings?

A frequent goal of native vegetation restoration is to create new habitat for native wildlife. However, few revegetation initiatives have post-planting monitoring. Such monitoring could provide valuable information, helping to make these revegetation efforts as successful as they can be. Monitoring is rare as it is often seen as being expensive and technically difficult. Stacey will talk about a bird survey of habitat re-plantings underway in Brisbane, sharing initial bird observations and dispelling some myths.

### Real birds eat squid

In our main talk, Nikolas will introduce us to the pelagic specialties of the Australian East Coast. He will focus on the biology, occurrence and identification of tubenoses - the albatrosses, shearwaters, petrels and storm-petrels.
