This case involves one (1) Eurasian Tree Sparrow, *Passer montanous*, observed on the 17<sup>th</sup> November 2022 at the Nurupai (Horn Island) airport (10° 35' 28"S 142° 17' 40"E), Torres Strait and a second bird observed opposite the Wongai Beach Hotel, (10° 35' 44"S 142° 14' 42"E) on the 18<sup>th</sup> November 2022. The submission was supported by a brief description of the bird which described the important identification characters of this species, including the distinctive chestnut crown and diagnostic black cheek spot.

Record accepted.

This is the seventh record of Eurasian Tree Sparrow to be assessed by the BQ RAC.
