#### THE QUEENSLAND ORNITHOLOGICAL SOCIETY BIRD REPORT, 1987.

#### D.I. REDHEAD

This fifth annual report lists bird records from Queensland for 1987. The publication of these records provides a permanent record for future reference, and focuses attention on particular areas. Many of these are under threat of development, particularly in coastal areas.

Three species new to Australia were added to the State List: an adult Gurney's Eagle at Boigu Island, Torres Strait in February; an adult female Black-backed Wagtail at Fraser Island from May to September; and a Laughing Gull at Cairns from December (two present into 1989).


Boat trips from Brisbane continue to provide new information about the status of seabirds, while observations from islands in the Torres Strait add significantly to our knowledge of migratory movements in eastern Australia.

Dry conditions, which were a feature of the previous two years, continued into 1987, particularly in the south-western, north-eastern and northcentral areas (Fig. 1). Large parts of coastal and sub-coastal areas from Brisbane to Cairns were also affected.

#### METHODS

Records included have been selected by the compiler. Omission from this report in no way implies that a record was considered erroneous. In addition to those submitted to the Q.O.S., records have been abstracted from the 1987 issues of The Bird Observers Club Newsletter, Q.O.S. Newsletter, R.A.O.U. Newsletter and *Cosmic Flashes* Newsletter.




FIG.2. Queensland districts mentioned in the text. (from Dahms, in Palliser 1985)

The format used conforms to that used in the 1986 Bird Report (Redhead 1988). Nomenclature follows Schodde *et al.* (1978). The regional location (Fig. 2) is given in parenthesis for less well-known localities. Initials of the observers appear after the date of each record.

#### DOUBLE-BARRED FINCH ON NORTH STRADBROKE ISLAND

#### PETER F. WOODALL

Small flocks of Double-barred Finch *Poephila bichenovii* were seen at Adam's Beach, Point Lookout and Eighteen-mile Swamp during a brief visit to North Stradbroke Island from 12-15 September, 1988. These sightings suggested that the species was reasonably common and widely distributed on the island.

While widespread in south-east Queensland, this species seems to be a recent addition to the island's avifauna. It was not included in bird lists for the island compiled by Vernon & Martin (1975a) or by Durbridge & Covacevich (1981), and it was not recorded on any of the QOS annual bird counts for North Stradbroke Island from 1973-1980 (Woodall 1987). It is also absent from bird lists for Fraser Island (Vernon & Barry 1972) and Moreton Island (Vernon & Martin 1975b). Island locations are not given for it in Storr's (1973) list of Queensland birds but it is recorded for the Moreton Bay islands (Bribie, Moreton, St. Helena, North Stradbroke, Peel) in his revised list (Storr 1984).

The Double-barred Finch has expanded its range into eastern coastal areas this century (Immelmann 1967; Blakers *et al.* 1984). An analysis of finches recorded during QOS bird counts around Brisbane, 1972–1983, indicated that most Double-barred Finches were counted away from the coast (Woodall 1987). However, from 1979 - 1981 there was an apparent influx of this species to coastal areas, and it is possible that this may have extended to some of the islands of Moreton Bay, resulting in the colonisation of North Stradbroke Island.

It is regrettable that comparative lack of material received in 1989 has meant that we were able to produce only a single issue in Volume 19. There will be at least two issues in Volume 20, the second of which should be published in July. Whether or not there are more 1990 issues depends on suitable material being submitted in the near future. It is hoped that we are able to revert to three or four issues per year.

#### THE QUEENSLAND ORNITHOLOGICAL SOCIETY BIRD REPORT, 1988.

#### P.L. BRITTON

This sixth annual report lists bird records from Queensland for 1988. The publication of these sightings continues to provide a permanent record for future reference, focusing attention on particular areas as well as seasonal patterns of occurrence. Cumulative data over decades will assist in our understanding of these complex patterns, which are often obscure in a continent noted for climatic vicissitudes. The inevitable effects of clearing and other forms of environmental degradation can be likewise monitored when sufficient long-term data are available for perusal.

Observations at Boigu Island in Torres Strait again resulted in an addition to the State List. This Singing Starling, still lacking proper documentation, was in fact new to the Australian avifauna. A New Guinea Pied Harrier casually reported from two localities was also an addition to the State List, while migrant Grey Wagtail, Red-necked Phalarope, Red-rumped Swallow, Asian Dowitcher and Garganey from the Northern Hemisphere are hardly recorded.

More than half of the State experienced below average rainfall in 1988 (Fig.1). The extent of the average rainfall area is misleading in terms of exceptional rain in many areas in December, which lifted annual rainfall and provided unusually verdant conditions at the end of the year.

#### METHODS

Records included have been selected by the compiler. Omission from this report in no way implies that a record was considered erroneous. It is regrettable that virtually all data other than the compiler's are already published in standard sources such as the Q.O.S. Newsletter. Such sources tend to focus on the rare or atypical, whereas data submitted for the report itself allow the compiler to select interesting items which might appear to be random when viewed in isolation. A wealth of data is certainly preferred, so that sifting or selection is possible in terms of correlation from locality to locality. The data presented for Black-tailed Native-hen and White-winged Triller from Georgetown and Charters Towers illustrate this potential.




FIG.2. Queensland districts mentioned in the text. (from Dahms, in Palliser 1985)

Format, nomenclature, abbreviations and sources for published records are as used in the 1986 Bird Report (Redhead 1988). The regional location (Fig.2) is given in parenthesis for less well-known localities the first time each appears. Initials of the observers appear after other details of each record. A lack of proper documentation is referred to in some instances, when a record is of particular interest and thus in special need of such. Various other cases of inadequate documentation are not referred to specifically. It is hoped that rare species which are difficult to identify (for example Long-toed Stint) and sightings which represent extensions of known range (for example Blackbrowed Albatross) will be fully documented elsewhere, as already done by Cheshire (1989) for the latter species.





#### **INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS**

The Sunbird is published quarterly by the Queensland Ornithological Society to further the knowledge of birds in Queensland and adjacent northern regions of Australia.

Papers are invited from non-members as well as members on all aspects of ornithology, e.g. life history, taxonomy, distribution, behaviour, and ecology. Articles may take the form of major articles on specific birds, birds in specific areas or habitats, or short notes on either birds themselves or the literature on birds, such as reviews of books or comments on published articles.

Submission of a paper implies that the results reported have not been published and are not being considered for publication elsewhere. The editor reserves the right to submit records of rare birds to the Records Appraisal Committee of the Royal Australasian Ornithologists Union.

Manuscripts should be typed (if possible), double-spaced and two (2) copies sent. Papers longer than four (4) typed A4 pages should have a summary. If needed, help may be given to authors to find relevant literature. Common names, scientific names and order of names should follow "Recommended English Names for Australian Birds", in *The Emu* Volume 77, Supplement, 1978. Intending authors should consult recent issues of **The Sunbird** to see acceptable forms of contributions.

References should be listed in alphabetical order at the end of papers in the following styles, titles of journals will be abbreviated as in the World List of Scientific Periodicals:
